- Structure and permeability

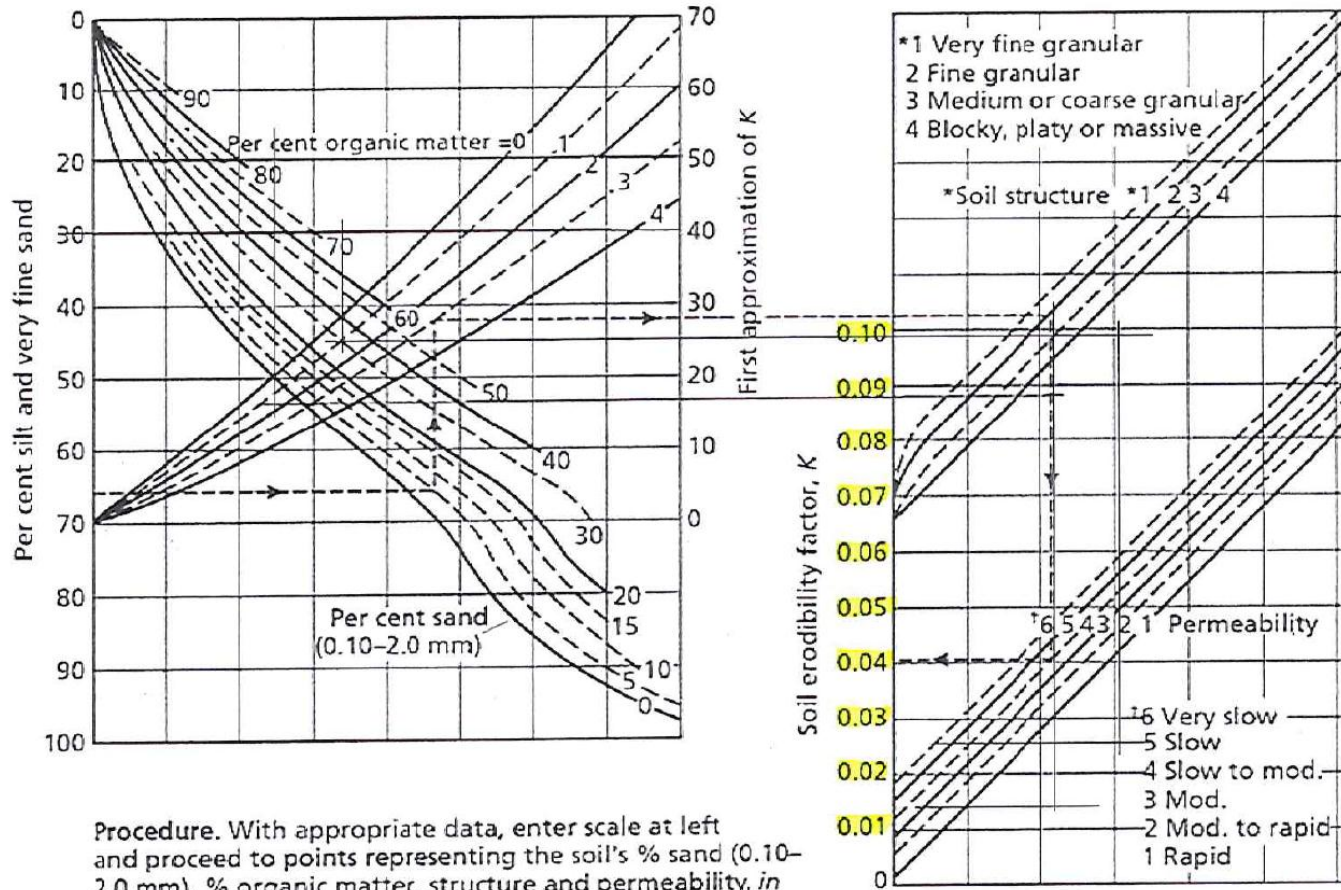

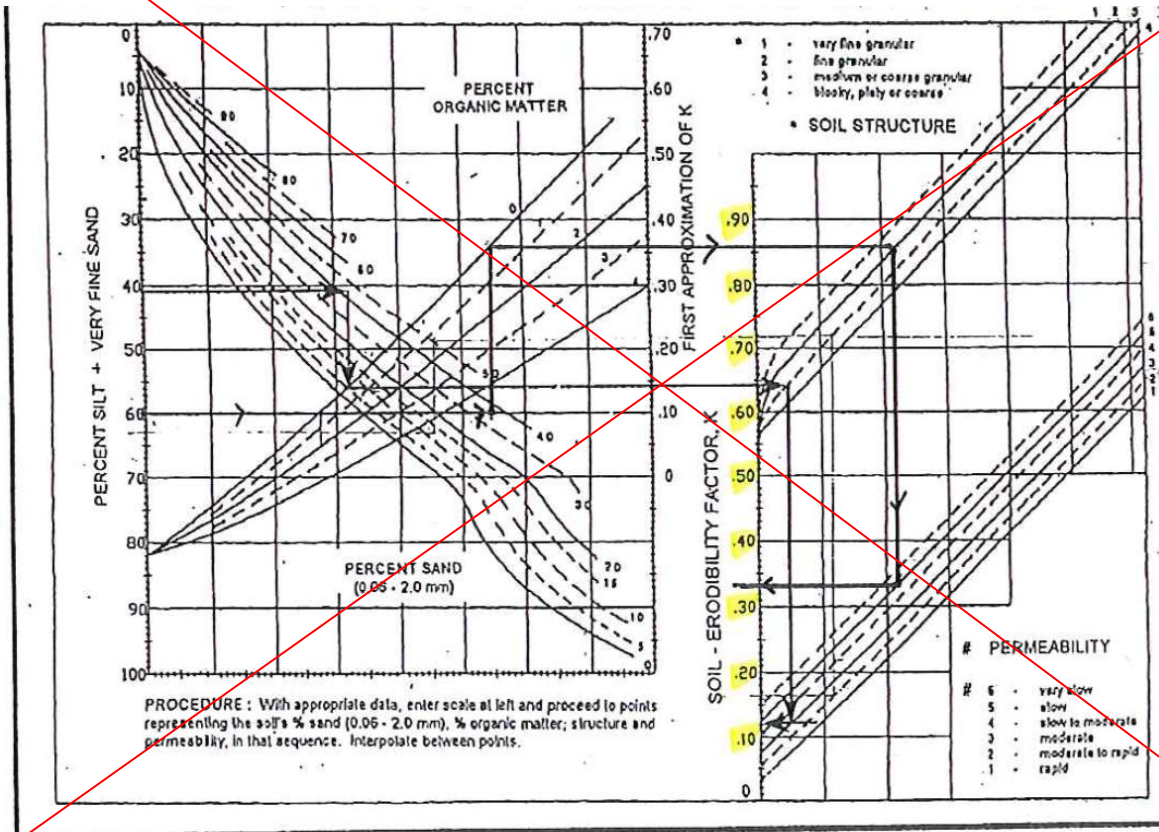
