## Re: Office Closure in Compliance with Extension of COVID-19 Circuit Breaker

The Government announced a set of 'Circuit Breaker' measures on 3 April 2020 to reduce the risk of increasing local transmission of COVID-19. As of 21 April 2020, this has been extended. In line with the measure for suspension of activities at workplace premises, IES and IES Academy will be temporarily closed from 7 April 2020 (Tue) to 1 June 2020 (Mon), both dates inclusive.
