Part 1: What is Supervision and why is Supervision important

This session discusses the need for Supervision in the construction activity. The discussion will focus on the areas where supervision is critical, required, important or good practice. Statutory and Regulatory requirements will also be discussed, together with relevant references and codes of practice.

Part 2: Paperwork for Supervisors

Paperwork for supervisors covers the necessary inspection/witnessing/non-conformance forms, reporting of supervision activities and of construction in general, and also site memos. This will cover topics of the standard forms and necessary details, the reports (daily reports or diaries, weekly reports, monthly summary and milestone reports) and also site memos to the contractors.

Part 3: Supervision of Typical Construction Works

This session presents required and general supervisory requirements for various typical construction activities, including earthworks/excavations, foundation works, concrete construction, pre-stressing, steel construction and pre-fabrication.

Part 4: Safety Aspects of Construction Supervision

Current industrial practice places a substantial portion of safety responsibility on site supervisors. Site supervisors should be above to identify safety from the following perspectives – self, workers, public, construction activities, structural works, project level. There is a duty for RE/RTO to report unsafe acts, being a representative of the QP(Sup) and for site supervisors to likewise do the same, being representative of the Builder.

Yow Cheong Hoe has more than 20 years of experience (more than 15 as a Professional Engineer) in the design, supervision, construction and contract management of construction projects, local and overseas. He has direct experience in civil & structural planning, analysis and design, construction support and project management including serving as the Superintending Officer or the SO Representative in his projects. He is also a Risk Assessment Manager (BizSAFE Level 2), an ISO Auditor, a Design for Safety Professional and a Qualified Erosion Control Professional.

He is well versed with design and supervision of reinforced concrete, pre-stressed concrete, structural steel, strutted and top-down excavations, fibre-reinforcement, bridges and tunnels (for roads, railways and utilities), infrastructure (roads, drains, sewers, utilities), earthworks (land preparation) and master-planning. He spent more than two years in full-time supervision as Resident Engineer for the construction of the award-winning Keppel Bay Bridge, a cable-stayed bridge constructed over the sea. His supervision experience includes earthworks, reclamation works, bored piling on land and sea, short-line match-cast and long-line bridge segment pre-casting and installation, heavy lifting by cantilever gantry, traveling gantry and marine cranes, post-tensioned pre-stressing, stay-cables installation, pre-cast elements on buildings, steel structures, fibre-reinforcements, excavations and slopes.

Er. Yow was previously a design consultant with T.Y.Lin International and KTP Consultants (part of Surbana Jurong Group) and is currently the Commercial Engineering Director of Chye Joo Construction. He is actively involved in various engineering and social committees and activities.
