# INCREASING PRODUCTIVITY : NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN CONSTRUCTION METHODS & MATERIALS – 6<sup>th</sup> RUN

# **Introduction**

Development projects are increasingly demanding as the clients becomes more sophisticated and requires their project to be built with better productivity and sustainability. At the same time, over the years there has being a gradual accumulation of practical experience around the world on specific methods of construction like prefabricated-prefinished volumetric construction (PPVC) and materials like selfcompacting concrete (SCC) and cross laminated timber (CLT).

These materials and method of construction may be considered as a means to achieve sustainability and improve productivity under the right conditions. Stakeholders (Designers, Resident Engineers, Resident Technical Officers, Site Supervisors, etc) would need to have some understanding of how these materials and method can be used as they might be handling projects involving them.
