Increasing Productivity: New Developments in Construction Methods & Materials

INTRODUCTION

Development projects are increasingly demanding as the clients becomes more sophisticated and requires their project to be built with better productivity and sustainability. At the same time, over the years there has being a gradual accumulation of practical experience around the world on specific methods of construction like prefabricated- prefinished volumetric construction (PPVC) and materials like self- compacting concrete (SCC) and cross laminated timber (CLT). These materials and method of construction may be considered as a means to achieve sustainability and improve productivity under the right conditions. Stakeholders (Designers, Resident Engineers, Resident Technical Officers, Site Supervisors, etc) would need to have some understanding of how these materials and method can be used as they might be handling projects involving them.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of the programme is to let stakeholders understand the basic issues related to PPVC. Participants will also learn about what is SCC and the types of site/laboratory testing that can be done on SCC. The handling of CLT including connections and lifting of members together with performance attributes likes sound control and fire insulation will be shared with participants. The programme will cover the different Constituent Materials with reference to the SS544 Part 2 Concrete – Complementary Singapore Standard to SS EN 206 – Part 2: Specification for Constituent Materials and Concrete.
