

Site Visit to T226 Marina Bay Station (21 Marina Station Road)





For the first time in Singapore's rail history, the technique of ground 1the soil during construction of Singapore's new Thomson-East Coast Line (TEL) Marina Bay Station. The works are underway to build a pedestrian walkway and the two tunnels, Thomson Line tunnels, one on top of the other, underneath the existing lines. To do this, the team has utilized a rectangular shield tunneling machine to cut away a section of approximately 20 existing piles that support the North-South Line's tunnel. The level of complexity is raised as the current live RT lines are in use coupled with the poor soil conditions which make the project even more challenging.
