The 30-km long Thomson Line will connect the northern and central parts of Singapore to the city and the rest of the MRT network, provide additional capacity along the north-south corridors, and strengthen the overall resilience of the rail network. Fully underground, Thomson Line comprises 22 stations including six interchange stations: Woodlands, Caldecott, Stevens, Orchard, Outram Park and Marina Bay. These interchange stations will link to the North-South-East-West Line (NSEWL), Downtown Line (DTL), North East Line (NEL) and Circle Line (CCL), providing greater accessibility and significantly improving travel time for commuters.
