



IES Scholarship

The Institution of Engineers, Singapore Scholarship (“IES Scholarship”) is established to support deserving Singapore citizens or permanent residents pursuing full-time undergraduate engineering/technology-related degree in local universities, full-time engineering/technology-related diploma programmes in local polytechnics and, full-time Nitec and Higher Nitec programmes in Engineering or technology-related programme in the Institute of Technical Education (ITE).

IES Scholarships will be awarded to full-time students who are deeply passionate about engineering and have excellent academic and co-curricular activities records. Applicants who face financial hurdles in seeking an engineering education would be given priority over others who have similar excellent academic and co-curricular activities records.

IES Scholars are expected to contribute to the engineering community in Singapore and develop into dynamic global leaders capable of effecting positive societal change after they graduate and progress in their engineering careers.

2026 IES Scholarship is now open for applications. All applications shall be submitted electronically to scholarship@iesnet.org.sg using the electronic IES Scholarship Application Forms which is to be found on the following Institution of Engineers, Singapore website: https://www.ies.org.sg/wp-content/uploads/IES-Scholarship-2026_new.pdf

Closing date for the application will be on (25/08/2026). Applicants are advised to submit their applications early. There will not be any extension of the closing date and late applications will not be accepted.

1. IES Scholarship Application for Full-time Undergraduate Degree Programme

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

Applicable to undergraduates enrolled in full-time engineering degree programmes offered at any of the local universities in Singapore:

- Singapore citizen or permanent resident
- Possess good academic performance:
 - For 2026 IES Scholarship, we will only accept first-year university students matriculated into a full-time engineering/technology-related undergraduate programme at a local university in 2026; and
 - Good GCE A-Level certification, Polytechnic Diploma, International Baccalaureate Diploma or NUS High School Diploma.
- Have good co-curricular activities record;
- Have a record of good character;
- Good performance at selection interview; and
- Priority will be given to students with demonstrated financial needs [based on Household Per Capita Income (PCI)].

Benefits and Obligation of Scholarship

- Each IES Scholarship is valued at \$9,000, is applicable for each academic year without any bond.
- IES Scholarship will be subject to review before the start of every subsequent academic year and it will be renewed if the recipient maintains good academic performance in the preceding academic year and good conduct at all times.

IES Scholarship recipients may not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance without the prior approval of IES.

2. IES Scholarship Application for Full-time Polytechnic Diploma Programme

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

Applicable to students enrolled in full-time engineering diploma programmes offered at any of the local polytechnics in Singapore:

- Singapore citizen or permanent resident
- Possess good academic performance:
 - For 2026 IES Scholarship, we will only accept first-year polytechnic diploma students matriculated into a full-time engineering/technology-related diploma programme at a local polytechnic in 2026; and
 - Good GCE O- or A-Level certification, International Baccalaureate Diploma or NUS High School Diploma.
- Have good co-curricular activities record;
- Have a record of good character;
- Good performance at selection interview; and
- Priority will be given to students with demonstrated financial needs [based on Household Per Capita Income (PCI)].

Benefits and Obligation of Scholarship

- Each IES Scholarship is valued at \$6,000, is applicable for each academic year without any bond.
- IES Scholarship will be subject to review before the start of every subsequent academic year and it will be renewed if the recipient maintains good academic performance in the preceding academic year and good conduct at all times.

IES Scholarship recipients may not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance without the prior approval of IES.

3. IES Scholarship Application for Full-time ITE Nitec/Higher Nitec Programme

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

Applicable to all students enrolled in full-time Nitec/Higher Nitec Programme offered at the Institute of Technical Education:

- Singapore citizen or permanent resident
- Possess good academic performance:- For 2026 IES Scholarship, we will only accept first-year students matriculated into a full-time engineering/technology-related Nitec and Higher Nitec programme at the Institute of Technical Education in 2026.
- Have good co-curricular activities record;
- Have a record of good character;
- Good performance at selection interview; and
- Priority will be given to students with demonstrated financial needs [based on Household Per Capita Income (PCI)].

Benefits and Obligation of Scholarship

- Each IES Scholarship is valued at \$4,000, is applicable for each academic year without any bond.
- IES Scholarship will be subject to review before the start of every subsequent academic year and it will be renewed if the recipient maintains good academic performance in the preceding academic year and good conduct at all times.

IES Scholarship recipients may not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, bursary, grant, award or allowance without the prior approval of IES.

4. Additional Benefits for all categories of IES Scholarship

Besides benefits stated under each category of IES Scholarship, recipients will also enjoy the following benefits:

- an annual voucher to enrol into any engineering/technology-related training course provided by IES Academy (“IESA”) or IES Incubator-Accelerator (“IES-INCA”) during his or her programme of study and term of scholarship;
- admission to IES Student Chapter of the respective university, polytechnic or ITE;
- invitation to an annual dialogue session with a panel consisting of IES Fellows from the College of Fellows on engineering or technology-related topics.

Appendix

Rules of IES Scholarship Award (to be attached to IES Scholarship Application Form)

1. Any applicant who has been found to have submitted untrue declaration or false record/document together with the e-application will be disqualified immediately and any scholar monies disbursed will be recovered from the applicant/award recipient.
2. At the close of the application, IES will shortlist applicants for selection interview. Only shortlisted applicants will be notified for an interview via e-mail. Applicants that are not shortlisted will not receive any e-mail communication.
3. Applicants shall ensure that they are available to attend the interviews in order to be considered for the IES Scholarship. Application will be disqualified if an applicant is unable to attend any scheduled interview without valid reason.
4. Short-listed applicants will also be required to show proof of their Household Per Capita Income at the selection interview. Applicants who are not able to show proof of their Household Per Capita Income may be disqualified for interview.
5. Applicants will be evaluated for scholarship suitability based on the strength of their applications and their performance at the scholarship selection interview to be conducted by an IES Selection Committee.
6. Scholarship selection interviews will take place in September to October 2025:
 - i. for undergraduate programme applicants;
 - ii. for polytechnic diploma programme applicants; and
 - iii. for Nitec/Higher Nitec programme applicants.
7. All applicants who have attended the selection interviews will be informed of their scholarship application outcomes within one month after the interviews.
8. IES reserve the right not to award any scholarship if there are no candidates of sufficient merit. The decision of the IES Selection Committee is final. Enquiries or disputes surrounding its decisions will not be entertained.
9. IES Scholarship award recipients will formally receive the disbursement of the scholarship cash amounts at an IES event to be decided by the IES Council.
10. However, IES Scholarship award recipients who need to have the scholarship cash amounts to be disbursed to them may apply in writing for an earlier disbursement with valid reason(s). Early disbursement of any scholarship cash amount will be at the sole discretion of the IES Council.
